2019 was a time of much transition for our congregation. We spent the first half of the year preparing for the retirement of long-time pastor, James E. Thyren, and spent the second half of the year making adjustments after his retirement. In between, we hired a new Administrative Assistant, John Baer, and a new Organist/Choir Director, David Hunisch.

In early 2019, the Transition Team, comprised of Emily Christ, Dan Klaproth, Bettie Ann Morgan, Marge Rosa, Jim Zeigler, and Barb Fleming (from the Wyoming Presbyterian Church), prepared and led the congregation through a Mission Study consisting of four 2-hour workshops. Members of the Wyoming Presbyterian Church also participated this Mission Study, anticipating the retirement of their Commissioned Pastor Laura Lewis.

On April 26, 2019, the congregation hosted a retirement party at the Irem Temple Country Club celebrating the 30+ years of ministry together with Rev. James E. Thyren and Organist/Choir Director Jan Thyren.

Upon completion of the Mission Study gatherings, members of the Transition Team used information learned during the Mission Study to create the Ministry Information Form to begin advertising for a Transitional Pastor and screen applicants as they applied for the position.

Beginning on June 2, 2019, the congregations of the First United Presbyterian Church of West Pittston and the Wyoming Presbyterian Church began worshipping jointly on Sunday mornings, with services led by Rev. James Thyren and Commissioned Pastor Laura Lewis Emmett.

Upon the retirement of Rev. James E. Thyren on June 30, 2019, Commissioned Pastor Laura Lewis-Emmitt began providing pastoral services to our congregation, and we continued worshipping jointly with the members of the Wyoming Presbyterian Church on Sunday mornings. Rev. Bill Carter was appointed Moderator of Session and has provided thoughtful guidance and steady leadership during this time of transition.

In December 2019, the Transition Team made a recommendation to the Sessions of the First United Presbyterian Church of West Pittston and the Wyoming Presbyterian Church to jointly hire the Rev. Dr. Martha Jordan to serve both congregations. At a joint Session meeting on December 10, 2019, the Sessions approved a 3-year contract with the Rev. Dr. Martha Jordan to serve in a fulltime capacity as Transitional Pastor of the First United Presbyterian Church of West Pittston and Stated Supply Pastor of the Wyoming Presbyterian Church, beginning on February 26, 2020.

We continue to be grateful for the faithful service of the members and friends of this congregation as we work towards our goal of being the hands and feet of Jesus Christ in daily life.

The Board of Deacons serves the congregation and the community by providing support to those in need. Whether it's visiting our shut-ins from our church, preparing college care packages to those who are away at school, or during the holidays making gift baskets for our homebound members.

During 2019, the Board of Deacons organized the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Soup Off for our congregation and invited the members of the Wyoming Church to attend. We held the Strawberry Festival in June of this year also. We also received a lot of help from members of our congregation.

At the end of the year, the Deacons participate in multiple programs to assist those in need. We adopted a family through the Salvation Army; buying food, gifts and making it so the family didn't go without for the holidays. We also participate in the Angel Tree for the Salvation Army where members of our congregation help in giving toys/clothes to children in need.

In 2019, The Deacons helped the Shawn C. Malone Memorial have nut roll fundraiser. On November 16<sup>th</sup> we made over 200 nut rolls to distribute the next day at church. We were able to raise \$2,210 to help replenish the Shawn C. Malone Memorial, so that they could help our church family kids go to camp this year. We hope to continue this fundraiser every year to benefit this organization.

Our congregation helps with funding the Board of Deacons with our loose plate offering on communion Sundays, proceeds of the food/baked goods stand at the Strawberry Festival, gifts or donations from fellowship dinners and Church World Service Sunday along with individual donations by members of our congregation. We rely heavily on the profits from the Strawberry Festival to supplement our funds for the year so we can help others. Especially during the holiday season for Adopt A Family.

The Board of Deacons often have to work short-handed due to work or scheduling conflicts, the current Deacons are grateful to the Deacon alumni and the youth of the church for all their help preparing for events and donating their time. Goals for 2020, we hope to continue the Shawn C. Malone Memorial Fundraiser. We just hope to continue serving this congregation and helping those in the community in need.
